

## **Dr. J.P. (Jack) London, CACI Executive Chairman and Chairman of the Board, Receives U.S. Naval Academy Distinguished Graduate Award**

The recognition, awarded by a Naval Academy Alumni Association panel chaired by former Chief of Naval Operations Admiral Jonathan W.
